#### WHY ARE WE NEEDED?

In the past, the presence, intimacy, and support that is needed during the childbearing years was found in the structures of family, neighborhood, community and church. Today, these structures are undergoing rapid change. Our neighborhoods are fragmented, leaving many people isolated. Our churches have increased in size, making it very difficult to create a hospitable and loving environment. Mobility has caused many extended families to be separated by miles. That makes frequent visits impossible. Yet, the wisdom drawn from sharing stories of the joys, challenges and sorrows of marriage, intimacy and fertility issues, childbearing, parenting and other relationships is still needed. The support, guidance and reassurance, usually given by the extended family, often now needs to come from another source. One way to respond to this need is Elizabeth Ministry.

Scientific discoveries have transformed the experiences of fertility concerns, family planning and pregnancy in the past few decades. Assisted reproductive technologies have a moral, ethical and social impact that did not exist for previous generations. Elizabeth Ministry can offer information and insight in evaluating the many options.

The profound effects of a sexually promiscuous society and abortion has caused social decay and built a culture of death. The many medical, social and spiritual consequences need to be addressed. Elizabeth Ministry makes available life-giving opportunities for healing.

Elizabeth Ministry seeks to provide insight and support through sharing lived experiences, mentoring, prayer, blessings, scripture, church teachings, retreats, programs, scientific information, consultations, referrals, trainings, gifts, resources and other assistance.



Understanding the dignity of human sexuality and the power of procreation will enhance relationships, build up the family and create healthy communities!

#### **HOW DOES IT WORK?**

Elizabeth Ministry International helps churches form Elizabeth Ministry Chapters. Over 700 chapters have registered on six continents. These chapters recruit volunteers to become Elizabeth Ministry mentors in the areas they have experienced. For example, a woman who has twins would visit and mentor a woman who is pregnant with twins. Support is given throughout the pregnancy and after the birth. This support comes in the form of visits, phone calls, cards, prayer, e-mails, resources and other assistance. Elizabeth Ministers share their presence, stories, and experiences in the hope that these will encourage a woman and her family. Fathers, siblings, grandparents and others receive encouragement along with the mother. Many times an Elizabeth Minister will deliver a Gift & Resource Kit as a tangible sign of care and connectedness. An Elizabeth Minister will be a link with the local church community.

#### WHO MAY PARTICIPATE?

Volunteers who become Elizabeth Ministers must make a commitment to uphold the dignity and worth of all life before, during and after conception until natural death and beyond. People serve as a mentor or may participate in behind the scenes support. Men, as well as women, can join Elizabeth Ministry.

#### WHAT ARE THE AREAS OF INVOLVEMENT?

Each chapter selects the areas of involvement their church will address, based on experiences and interest of their members. The primary areas of chapter activity and mentoring are related to the joys, challenges and sorrows of the childbearing experience. The Elizabeth Ministry International Headquarters offers resources and enrichment opportunities for those chapters that want to include activities related to chaste living issues.
